[] Yes [X] No If no, describe, whenever possible, how and why it deviates from the international standard: Wheat and Corn (maize, including pop corn and sweet corn) The current MRLs for Fenitrothion in wheat and corn (including popcorn and sweet corn) are lower than the Codex ones due to dietary exposure and domestic residue data in Japan. From the revaluation of them, the MRL for corn further decreases to 0.1 ppm during this meeting. 9.
